

Our Most Frequently Asked Questions...

1) How long is the class semester?

* Our Fall Semester runs September 14th thru December 14th.

2) Will there be a show at the end of the semester?

* For the Recreational Division, the Fall semester culminates in a Lecture/Demonstration style presentation, while the Spring semester culminates in a large scale production. Our Overture Division Students will actually perform/ minister in several shows over the course of both semesters. (See our EAS Calendar/Overture Division Events for details)

3) What is the difference between the Overture and Recreational Division?

* Primarily, it has to do with goals and performance/ministry opportunities. Overture Division Students are committed to a program that trains them technically and spiritually in preparation for performances/ministry. They are required to meet with other Overture Division students twice a week for technique, Bible, production, and rehearsal time. The Recreational Division is for those students primarily interested in technique classes alone.

4) What is the difference between Overture I and Overture II?

* Overture I, generally speaking, is for our younger students (ages 8-14) whose time commitment or technique might be at a lesser degree.

* Overture II provides training for our older students (ages 14- adult) who can make a larger time commitment and are striving for a higher level of technique.

5) Can I register for more than one Overture track, such as Theatre and Vocal Music?

* Yes, you can. You would just need to contact the office to work out the scheduling details. Realizing many artists are multi-talented in varied art forms, we encourage cross- training in all of our artists.

6) Are there scholarships available?
